Here Miss Aimee reads one of her favourite stories: The Three Little Pigs!

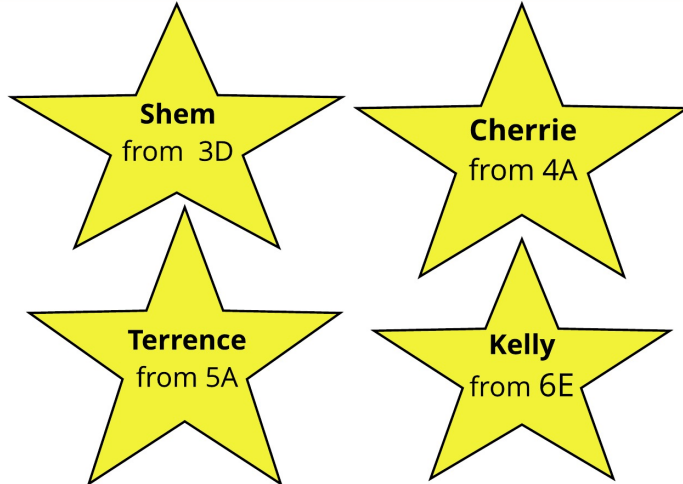


You can find either Miss Aimee or Miss Caroline reading a story in the playground during the first recess. Come along and read with them!
