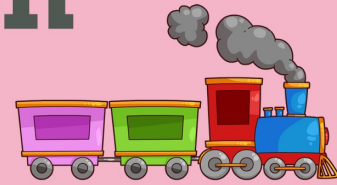

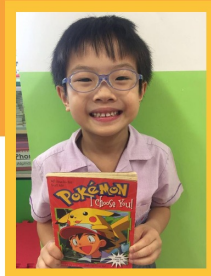
Favourite of the Month

Where: A high bridge with mountains around them.


Why: Mum wanted to have some fun and try something new!

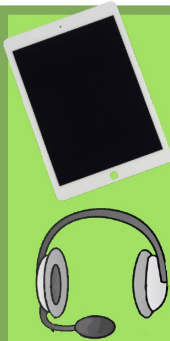
JUMP JAM™

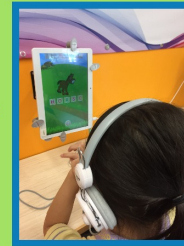


Digital Tablets

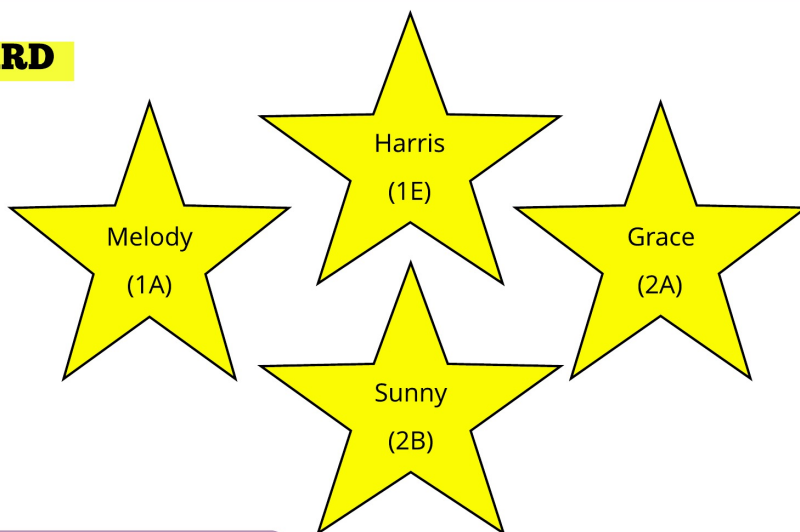
