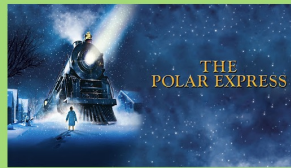

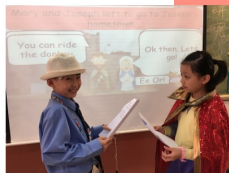


THE NATIVITY PLAY

CHRISTMAS CRAFTS



We have been making some Christmas crafts that you can try making!

Here are the instructions to help you!

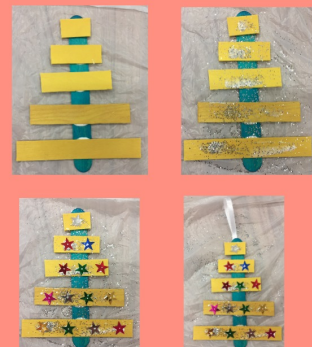
The materials you will need are:

- Coloured paper
- Glue
- Scissors
- Coloured pens
- Lollipop sticks
- Ribbon
- Glitter
- Sequins
- Googly eyes
- Tissue



Christmas Tree Decoration

1. Cut the lollipop sticks to various lengths.
2. Stick the lollipop sticks onto another stick using glue to make the branches.
3. Put some glue on the branches and shake glitter over them.
4. Stick stars on the branches using glue.
5. Glue ribbon to the back of the decoration so that you can hang it on the tree.



Santa and Elf Tree Decoration



1. Cut out a rectangular face and glue it onto the lollipop stick.
2. Use white tissue paper to make a beard for Santa.
3. Glue two googly eyes to the face. Draw a nose and a mouth.
4. Make Santa's hat using a piece of red card.
5. Make a black belt for Santa and a gold buckle then glue them onto the stick.
6. Glue ribbon onto the back to hang them on the tree.
